SASCO's Team of Verification Officer Grows by 25 to 75

In recognition of the fact that the South African weighing industry faces a significant skills deficit Sasco decided in late 2009 to form the Sasco Weighing Academy.

The objectives of the academy are simple, namely to provide Sasco with the human capital required to meet client's future weighing service needs. In March, 2010 suitable candidates with N4 or higher qualifications were accepted into the Academy.

The nine month program focused on providing trainees with a sound grounding in the theory of weighing, an in depth understanding of Sasco's instrumentation, and finally the ability write and pass the NRCS's verification exams and so qualify as Verification Officers.



The 2010 Graduates

Twenty five trainees graduated in December 2010 as Verification Officers and they are obliged under their contracts to work for Sasco for four years from graduation.

The addition of this new talent to Sasco's service resources, has resulted in the number of Sasco's verification officers increasing by 50% to 75
